A National Civic Partnership Advancing Integrity, Governance, and Collective Action in Civil Society

The Sharek Youth Forum, in partnership with the AMAN Coalition for Integrity and Accountability, convened the first national gathering of the Sharek Partners Alliance, bringing together representatives of civil society organizations from across Palestine.

The forum embodied a shared vision of unifying youth and institutional efforts to strengthen governance, transparency, and accountability within the civil society sector — cultivating a culture of collaboration, public responsibility, and collective impact in service of the common good.



From Vision to Action

The Sharek Partners Alliance is an open national network of youth and community organizations striving to build a Palestinian model of participatory civil work grounded in institutional complementarity, transparency, integrity, and accountability.

The alliance aims to empower youth and local institutions to play a proactive role in shaping public policies, combating corruption, and advancing social justice and sustainable development — all through a unified Palestinian lens toward a more transparent and equitable future.



Forum Themes: Governance, Transparency, and Social Impact

The forum featured a dynamic series of interactive and capacity-building sessions led by specialized experts, focusing on:

Principles of good governance and mechanisms to combat corruption in civil society;

Building institutional systems rooted in integrity and accountability;

Empowering youth as advocates for transparency and collective community engagement.



Stories of Change: Documenting Impact from the Field

Documenting success stories is a cornerstone of demonstrating real impact and social transformation.

Each story encapsulates the journey of change — highlighting tangible outcomes, amplifying trust between communities and institutions, and turning human experiences into tools for advocacy and influence.

Through professional storytelling and evidence-based documentation, success stories become powerful narratives that inspire others and reaffirm that civil society can indeed make a measurable difference on the ground.



Community Advocacy: From Ideas to Influence



Advocacy and public-pressure campaigns represent a core instrument for social change and civic participation. This track focused on equipping youth and organizations with practical skills to design and lead evidence-based, participatory advocacy initiatives — influencing public policy, defending transparency, and amplifying community voices to transform collective demands into concrete action.



Toward a Unified and Sustainable Alliance Vision

An open dialogue among alliance members shaped a shared vision, mission, and action plan for the coming year.

Discussions emphasized the importance of institutional cooperation, good governance, and accountability, ensuring sustainability and measurable impact within Palestinian society.

A Partnership Rooted in the Field, Growing Nationwide

With active participation from over 36 partner organizations and initiatives across Palestine — spanning youth centers, cultural clubs, women's associations, and community libraries — the forum served as a national platform for experience exchange, mutual learning, and trust-building among partners working toward common values of governance and transparency.

Extending the Partnership: A Growing National Alliance

The forum concluded with a reaffirmation of the collective spirit that has long united youth-led and civil society organizations across Palestine.

Participants agreed to expand the alliance to include more active partners and to develop a national Governance Index measuring transparency, accountability, and institutional integrity — transforming Sharek Partners Alliance into a sustainable national framework that drives coordinated action for youth empowerment and community development.



Governance Index: Next Steps Beyond the Forum

Following the forum, the alliance will launch a Governance Index to assess levels of transparency and institutional governance among partner organizations.

The index serves as a diagnostic tool to measure organizational readiness, promote good governance practices, and foster accountability and public trust.

This marks a new phase of action — turning dialogue into data, and partnership into measurable progress.
